On behalf of Teck Cominco Metals Limited, we would like to congratulate you and your employees for contributing to a Contractor Frequency and Severity rating of 0 (YTD June 21, 2004).

Since 1998, there has been a continuous improvement in the Health and Safety statistics of contractors working on our property. From a total of 16 Lost Time Incidents and a Frequency of 8.4 in 1999 to one Lost Time Incident and a Frequency of 1.4 and Severity of 2.8 in 2003, up to our current status of 0 LTI's resulting in a frequency of 0 (YTD June 21, 2004).

Many improvements have been made to the Safety and Health systems we have in place to work with contractors both by TCML, as well as the contractors we do business with. As you know there are hazards at any workplace. All must be identified and appropriate control measures put in place. If you have any questions or concerns regarding your jobsite please get them answered and/or resolved, do not let them linger – contact your Owner's Rep. or Contractor Coordinator. 
